One Day Training Program



One day training program on "Autodock Software-Molecular Docking" was arranged for B.Pharm Third year and M.Pharm First year students on Wednesday 15/06/2022. This event was organized by staff and student training cell YSPM YTC FOP, Satara. The session started by **Dr. Sachin Rohane** sir to introduce the topic of the seminar "Drug Discovery" and provided the audience with brief and important information about the topic, its history and its need in today's generation. Later, the demonstration of ChemDraw software was done by Ms. Anushka Kulkarni included an explanation of the tools and features of the software and how a structure is created and the basic properties of the structure were viewed. Ms. Tai Borkar explained the process of downloading a macromolecule from the Protein Data Bank and the importance of its conversion to a required format using the software Open Babel. It was followed by Ms. Anagha Bagal who demonstrated the software PyMol and explained how a macromolecule is cleaned by removing the unwanted ligands and water molecules, thus making it fit for the docking process. Later Ms. Aakanksha Kumbhar demonstrated in detail the procedure of the actual docking of the ligand and macromolecule by using the software Autodock and Vina Wizard. Ms. **Trupti Ghighe** continued the docking process in PyMol by generating a whole complex of the macromolecule and ligand and explained, in brief, its need and further use. Mr.Ganesh Devane gave a detailed explanation of Discovery Studio software Overall it was best experience for the students and they got aware with new technique of drug discovery. 
